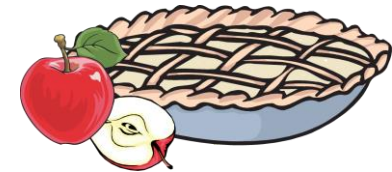

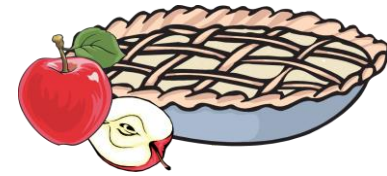
Any interested individual may enter the contest. Recipe entry forms and written recipe must be delivered on **OCTOBER 6** to the Cooperative Extension Tent at the Farmer's Market by 10:00 AM.

- Entries may be brought in any container (preferably disposable). It will not be the responsibility of the Festival to return any dishes or plates.
- Recipes must be original (not copyrighted).
- Standard measuring units should be used in all recipes.

- Individuals may enter only one recipe. **No previously submitted recipes.**
- All recipes must contain at least 1 cup of apple and be freshly homemade.
- Recipe will be judged on taste (40%, appearance (30%), and creative use of apple recipe (30%)
- No items requiring refrigeration will be accepted due to lack of refrigeration facilities.
- All recipes become the property of the Heritage Day Festival Committee and the Cooperative Extension Service - Polk County Center. Entry constitutes permission to edit, modify, adapt, publish and otherwise use the recipe in any way without further compensation. If recipe is published credit will be given to the baker.
- **participants must bring the entire finished product to Cooperative Extension Booth at the Columbus Court House Square for judging on Saturday, October 6, by 10:00 a.m.. Judging will begin at 11:00 am**
- The judges' decisions are final for interpretation of any and all rules related to the contest.
- Contact the Polk County Extension Center if you have any questions at 894-8218.
- **Participants may pick up their entries after prizes are awarded.**
